To the members of First Baptist Church Shelby, In Christ, we have united in prayer and support in search of our Lead Pastor. Operating under the mantra "Father, not my will, but His be done", we are truly excited to present Asher Panton to the congregation! The journey began by working with Dr. Bill Wilson of Center for Healthy Churches. Our faithful church membership spent several Sunday afternoons in roundtable discussions creating a profile and identifying traits we desired our Lead Pastor to display. The Transition Team sifted through this information and assembled the results to help create the profile of our leader. They also updated the church profile in detail, and that was very instrumental in sharing our church and community with candidates.
